About the service

FRWA will provide weekly collection of food and organic waste from businesses in 140L green kerbside bins for an annual fee of \$175 per bin.

Bins, lids and compostable bin liners are available for purchase from FRWA.

Refer to the FRWA website for all terms and conditions.

How does the service work?

All compostable food and paper products are gathered in dedicated bins and collected weekly.

After collection, the organics are composted at a commercial compost facility.

Only use COMPOSTABLE bags

Compostable bags are made of natural plant starch, and do not produce any toxic material. Compostable bags break down readily in a composting system through microbial activity to form compost.



*In order to be classified as compostable they must meet the Australian Standard for compostability (AS-4736) and will have this symbol.

Never use BIODEGRADABLE bags

Biodegradable bags are not compostable and will contaminate the green organics bin and compost products.

Biodegradable bags have additives that over time break the plastic down into microplastics but do not completely dissolve them.

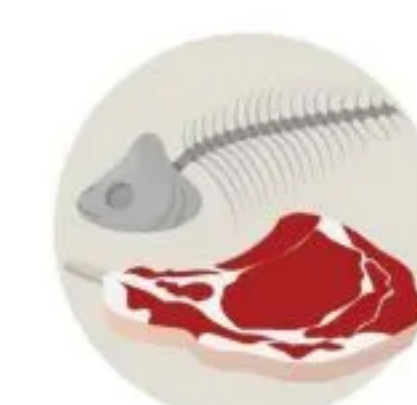

Milk or juice cartons



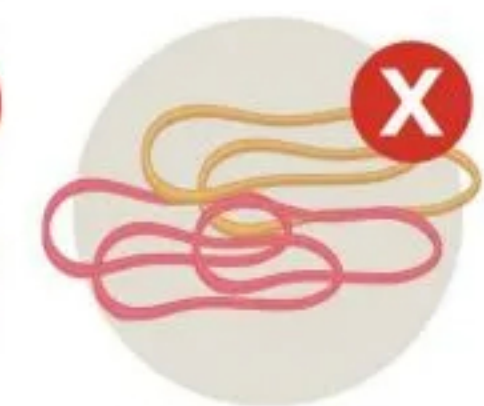
