



### **HOW TO USE THE KERBSIDE COLLECTION SYSTEM**

- · Place the right waste type in the right bin.
- · Put bins out on night before collection day.
- · Bring the bin in after collection.
- · Do not overfill maximum weight 75kgs.
- · Ensure your bin is not too tightly packed and the bin lid is closed.
- · Where practical leave a minimum distance of 50cm between bins and 1 metre between bins and parked cars, letterboxes, stobie poles or overhanging trees.





#### **COLLECTION ENQUIRIES**

Please contact FRWA on 08 8555 7405 for collection enquiries including missed collections.

Property owners are responsible for replacement and maintenance of their bins, including damaged, missing or stolen bins.

Bins may not be collected for the following reasons:

- Contamination with material that should not be placed in that bin
- · Weighing over 75 kg
- · Was the bin out before on the day of collection?
- $\cdot$  Was the right bin out on the right day?

#### **BIN CONTAMINANTS**

FRWA's waste collection trucks are fitted with a camera and conduct spot audits of the bins presented at the kerbside for collection.

Bins found to contain contaminants will not be emptied and a photograph will be taken and noted against the property. Residents can refer to the 'what goes in which bin' pages in this calendar to determine the offending material. The contaminants will need to be removed from the bin before next collection.

Households who continue to present their bins with contamination may be suspended from the kerbside waste collection service.

#### **BIN BANKS FOR REMOTE LOCATIONS**

FRWA collects bins from property driveways where possible. In remote locations where FRWA does not provide a roadside collection, bin banks are provided in dedicated locations for households to leave their bin. Bins at bin banks may be chained to the rail/stand unless marked 'do not chain' by the owner of the bin. Bin bank locations can be found on the FRWA website.







#### **CHOOSE TO RE-USE**

- · BYO drink bottles for water
- · Re-usable shopping bags
- Re-usable lunch boxes / wraps
- · Re-usable takeaway cups
- Donate clothing, towels and bedding to charity
- Re-use wrapping paper and single-sided print paper
- · Use modern cloth nappies

- Remove all lids before placing recyclables in the yellow bin
- · If you can scrunch a piece of plastic packaging in your

hand it is a soft plastic and must placed in the RED WASTE BIN or recycled at participating supermarkets

 Recycle bins that present with contamination will not be collected

### **GREEN ORGANICS TIPS**

- Never put green organics in plastic bags or use bin liners
- If you don't have grass or garden clippings, line your bin with newspaper, it will prevent smelly residue build up from your food scraps
- Max weight 75kg, so don't overload with wet grass clippings

## DON'T LET YOUR FOOD GO TO WASTE

Put it in the green organics bin to be composted.

Use a kitchen caddy to make collecting food scraps in the kitchen easy. You can line the caddy with newspaper or a compostable bag.

Replacement compostable bags are available from council offices.
